CTE Plan 2 Teacher Certification Courses

Cascadia Technical Academy is an approved provider of the Career and Technical Education (CTE) Plan 2 Teacher Certification Program pathway for obtaining the Washington State CTE Teaching Certificate from the Office of the Washington State Superintendent of Public Instruction. In order to qualify for the CTE Teaching Certificate, teachers must meet the OSPI Business and Industry (Specialty Program Areas) Requirements.

Certified and classified employees of Cascadia Technical Academy are allowed to take CTE Plan 2 certification courses free of charge. Cascadia Technical Academy started the Plan 2 classes in order to provide high quality education for our instructors coming out of industry. We continue to offer high quality education for CTE instructors all over the region. Allowing all Cascadia staff to enroll for free ensures instructors take the classes from Cascadia thus maintaining quality control and ultimately, higher quality learning for students.
