## Emergency Dental Clinics

*Patients must have a true dental emergency and display no risk factors for COVID.*

**Eligibility:** Patients must have a true dental emergency and display no risk factors for COVID-19 (or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19).

A dental emergency/urgent care as defined by the **American Dental Association** is potentially life threatening and requires immediate treatment to stop ongoing tissue bleeding, relieve severe pain and/or risk of infection and to alleviate the burden on hospital emergency departments.

If the patient has any **COVID-19 Symptoms** as defined by the CDC they **will not be treated** on the mobile clinic. We will screen for these symptoms curbside as well.

We seek to serve those without private insurance, who are low income and vulnerable populations, but we will not turn away a patient with emergency needs with no alternative options for care.



**Services:**

- Walk in only (no appointments)
- Free (donations accepted online)
- Dental emergencies only



**Safety:**

- Heightened infection control protocols
- Drive through triage
- Licensed Dental and Medical providers onsite
- Proper PPE is provided to staff and volunteers
